

CRITERIA FOR INDUCTION INTO THE IDAHO RODEO HALL OF FAME

Several criteria are considered for induction into the IRHF. Unless there are special circumstances and several recommendations by individuals who are respected in the industry, to be inducted the criteria is as follows:

- 1) Potential nominees must be officially nominated; the nomination form we provide sent in with their biographies in a timely manner and in the hands of the IRHF by the deadline. Photographs are required (a portrait or headshot and a rodeo or action photo related to their nomination category, ie; Announcer, Stock contractor, Rodeo Photographer etc. suitable for framing once they have been notified that they have been accepted for induction.
- 2) All nominees should be at least 50 years of age (subject to extenuating circumstances).
- 3) A Lengthy Rodeo career (subject to extenuating circumstances) is a determining factor.
- 4) Awards and/or accomplishments received are a determining factor by way of example an advocate of the sport or rodeo.
- 5) Had a history of competing, performing, or having contracted animals in Idaho, etc.
- 6) Recommendations from their peers.
- 7) Contributions they have made in furthering the careers of younger generations, involvement in community service activities focused on Rodeo.
- 8) Potential Inductees (or representative if posthumous induction) must sign a release form allowing us to use their photographs for publicity releases and publication in the media, social media, advertising of the inductions, etc. and on the IRHF website and social media.
- 9) **In order to be eligible for induction all nominees, board members (including officers and directors), Stock contractors, Rodeo committee members, and organizational representatives must commit to attending both nights of the Induction event.**
- 10) In the event of a posthumous induction, their representative or person receiving their award must be able to complete #9.
- 11) Inductees are expected to support the Idaho Rodeo Hall of Fame in whatever manner they can by donating silent auction items, making cash donations, volunteering, etc. and/or being involved in the future success of the Idaho Rodeo Hall of Fame in some way for longevity of and preservation of the IRHF and the legacies of those that have been inducted.
- 12) The Nomination Forms and biographies of the potential inductees are reviewed by the Idaho Rodeo Hall of Fame Board of Directors; a vote is taken, and a decision is made.
